<u>Public safety</u> – Tori reported that she has spoken with Orange County Sherriff Bohnyak about the FY2014 contract for public safety services. The budget runs on a July to June fiscal year, and the Sherriff is on track to meet the budgeted amount under the current contract and will likely renew for the same amount next year. The Sherriff further reported that Ed Eastman has been indispensable since the fire at the Burden's house, ensuring power supply to radio repeater with the Sherriff's office and staff is operational. The Sherriff will reimburse Ed Eastman for his mileage to the Burden's house

<u>2014 Budget</u> – Due to the absence of the Road Foreman, the Selectboard postponed further discussion of the town budget until 1/17/14.
