Rex Board Meeting

Present: Hilary, Leslie, Dave, Jason arrived at 6:15, Tori and John Lloyd joined via google meets and left at 6:20, Barb joined at 7 and left at 7:20

- Skatepark update - Michael Parker (construction of skateparks) is available for a site visit at the end of this week or next week. COuld put the project on his schedule in August. in 2020 they had looked at a 30x50 foot space, cost about \$60-70K. Needs a \$10K deposit, then ⅓ of payment before starting, and balance due. IT was discussed to have him come to investigate options since it is free, and ask the selectboard for a permanent location at the recycling center.
- Pocket Park - next step is to create a job description with the help of Barb. It was understood by the board that the board needed to be responsible for the town funds, and should have oversight of the budget and the hiring of a gardener. The board discussed having a subcommittee for the pocker park or whether the town would rather have a pocket park committee. Hilary will check with selectboard to see what the options are..
- Port-o-let is still there, Jason has left messages and we should not be charged for it even though it has been left there. We will need a new one in May, and it was suggested to buy one and have it pumped, it may be less costly. Dave will investigate options.
- Donation from Tilles family - they want to create a memorial to Leslie with some of their memorial fund. Want to provide something in memory, Jason will respond with a few recommendations and ensure they know they have to order and work on the logistics. Fiona will come to the next meeting with her final choices and we will work out the logistics.
- Mini golf on the go - email from a company who wants to set up mini golf and wants to know if we want to book. Rec Board was not interested but if individuals are interested we can provide contact info.
- Camps
 - Soccer camps is the week of June 17th, same people as last year
 - Tennis camp, Leslie will check with Karen D. on dates and willingness
 - Jedi Camp - need to ask Christa
 - Art camp - Leslie is working on dates, probably middle of August week of the 15th
 - Mountain Bike camp - Dan Gottlieb wants to start/run it, doesn't have dates or info yet but he spoke with Leslie who asked him to provide a proposal. Camp would be like all the otters, run independently and would need his own insurance.

- Better Places Grant - Leslie looked into it and it needs to be used within the town centers of one of the villages. Could consider trying to write it for the pocket park, perhaps a Gazebo or something similar. Board will brainstorm ideas and bring back to the next meeting/
