

Ashley Community Forest Board – Vacancy Announcement

The Ashley Community Forest Board is composed of five members. Two Strafford residents appointed by the Strafford Selectboard, two Sharon residents appointed by the Sharon Selectboard and a fifth “at-large” member appointed by the other four members. Due to a recent resignation, the Ashley Community Forest Board is seeking a new member from Strafford to complete a 3-year term.

Prospective Board members should be available for active participation in Board meetings and the oversight and management of the 256.4- acre Ashley Community Forest and should be knowledgeable in some or all aspects of the management of forests for outdoor education, ecological integrity, forest products, wildlife habitat or non-motorized recreation. Other skill sets associated with financial management, communications, technology, etc. will also be considered.

Interested individuals are asked to submit a brief letter of introduction and qualifications to the acting Secretary of the Ashley Community Forest Board, at kgish@sharonvt.gov as soon as possible.

Letters of interest will be reviewed at a regularly scheduled Ashley Community Forest Board meeting, and a recommendation for appointment will be made to the Strafford Selectboard shortly afterward.
