TOWN HOUSE ADVISORY GROUP MINUTES September 23, 2021

Attending: Rockwell Fuller, chair, Curt Albee, deputy chair, and Steve Handy

- 1. Rocky mentioned that there had been a request to rent the Town House in November by the Preservation Trust of Vermont. Given the continuing Covid pandemic, the committee felt this was a poor idea. Curt suggested that we steer the Trust toward Barrett Hall as its heating system is less conducive to circulating and thereby spreading the virus.
- 2. Bob McAllister has generously offered to pay to have two of the crabapple trees relocated directly in front of the Town House. Rocky will call E. C. Browns for a price for moving the trees before proceeding. This may be impractical but will be looked into to address Bob's concerns.
- 3. So far, we have received one estimate to replace the belfry railing. We are waiting for another.
- 4. Other maintenance projects that the committee needs to address include replacement of the door to accommodate handicap access, several door sills, which are in poor shape, and repair/replacement of the frame for the bell in the belfry.
- 5. The path to the backhouse and parts of the driveway needs some attention. Rocky will contact a local excavator for an estimate.
- 6. There are no future events scheduled at the Town House at this time because of Covid.
- 7. The next THAG meeting will occur on October 21 at 5 PM at the Town House. This is the last meeting at the Town House for the season. Future meetings will be held at the Morrill Ed. Ctr.
