Strafford Conservation Commission guided hike series for 2025 (tentative dates)

Morning bird walk with Marty Frank and Kathy Thompson at the Pocket Park May 3^{rd,} 8 to 9AM with Anne Fayen. Meet at the Pocket Park in South Strafford along the river behind the Red barn and the Rosa Tyson gym.

May 10th A spring ephemeral hike up Taylor Valley trail 1pm with Kate Bass. Meet at the parking area at the base of the Taylor Valley trail just where the town stops plowing.

May 31st hike at the Cobb Town Forest with Mike Hebb and Micki Colbeck to see the *Cypripedium parviflorum*, commonly known as **yellow lady's slipper**[©] and the *Cypripedium acaule*, the **pink lady's slipper** or **moccasin flower**. Meet at 10 AM at the Cobb Forest parking area on Hemenway Road.

June 28th, Saturday, Hike the rich fen at the Cobb Town Forest with Mike Hebb to see the *Cypripedium reginae*, known as the **showy lady's slipper**, **pink-and-white lady's-slipper**, or the **queen's lady's-slipper**. Meet at 10AM at the parking area at Cobb, up Hemenway Road.

July or August, Crafting with natural materials for children and families with Cortney Potter and Kate Bass at Old City Falls pavilion. Date to be announced.

June or August, children and family hike up Whitcomb Hill with J.T. Erbaugh. Date, to be announced.
