TOWN HOUSE ADVISORY GROUP MINUTES September 27, 2018

- 1. The spire and lantern were removed from the Town House today by crane. All went smoothly, taking less and two hours. The Valley News was present and interviewed Rocky and others involved with the project. An article in the paper is expected shortly. Repairs to the spire and lantern are expected to take roughly 30 days, with re-erection of the structure to occur at the beginning of November. Steve Willbanks suggested that some precautions should be taken to keep people away the ongoing construction while it is on the ground.
- 2. Mark Shaw gave a brief demonstration of the drone video he filmed of the spire before the project began.
- 3. Paul Kifner reported that the final music event of the season, Lydia Grey & Ed Eastridge, was a good show but poorly attended. Lydia and Ed would, however, like to return next year.
- 4. The painting of the west side of the Town House is done. The painters will be back to dip the spire shingles and paint the lantern shortly.
- 5. THAG's objectives following the completion of the spire and lantern restoration revolve around upgrading the Town House electrical wiring. Once we get estimates of costs for identified upgrades we can proceed to fund raise.
- 6. THAG's next meeting is scheduled fro Thursday October 18, 2018
