- 1. Rocky brought carpet samples for the board to review and choose a color for the center runner to be used for special occasions. The central aisle and bell tower entry will have a 4 foot runner in three pieces stretching from the front door to the steps to the stage. There will also be a six foot section of the same carpet for the stage that will be used to cover audio wires running to the microphones during performances. The cost of this has been covered by a generous donation.
- 2. There will be several more events this season: September 3 is another wedding, September 11 a recorder concert, and October 8 a memorial.
- 3. We are still waiting to hear about a proposal to replace the timber frame for the bell.
- 4. THAG Board size reduction proposal: Those regularly adding meetings want to reduce the size of the Group to 5 down from 9. Since the pandemic we have had fewer meetings and fewer official group members attending.
- 5. Grounds tune up: Rocky, Dave Taplin and Kenny Smith met last week to discuss grounds improvements to the Town House that include moving the path to the backhouse out of harm's way from snow sliding off the roof, improving the drainage on the west side of the building and making the handicap entry parking easier to navigate.
